

# Using Reflector wireless software to project your iPad's display or audio to the classroom PC

(Oct 20, 2015)

The Reflector software allows you to send whatever is being displayed on your iPad to the classroom PC, which is connected to the classroom projector.

Reflector works only when faculty log on to the HC secure network.

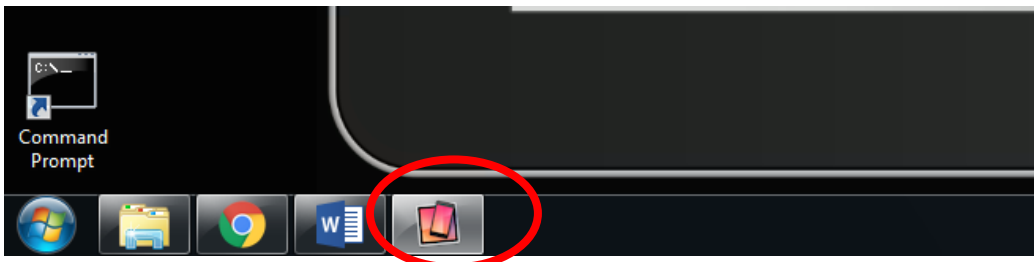
It will not show up when students or guests login.

To use:

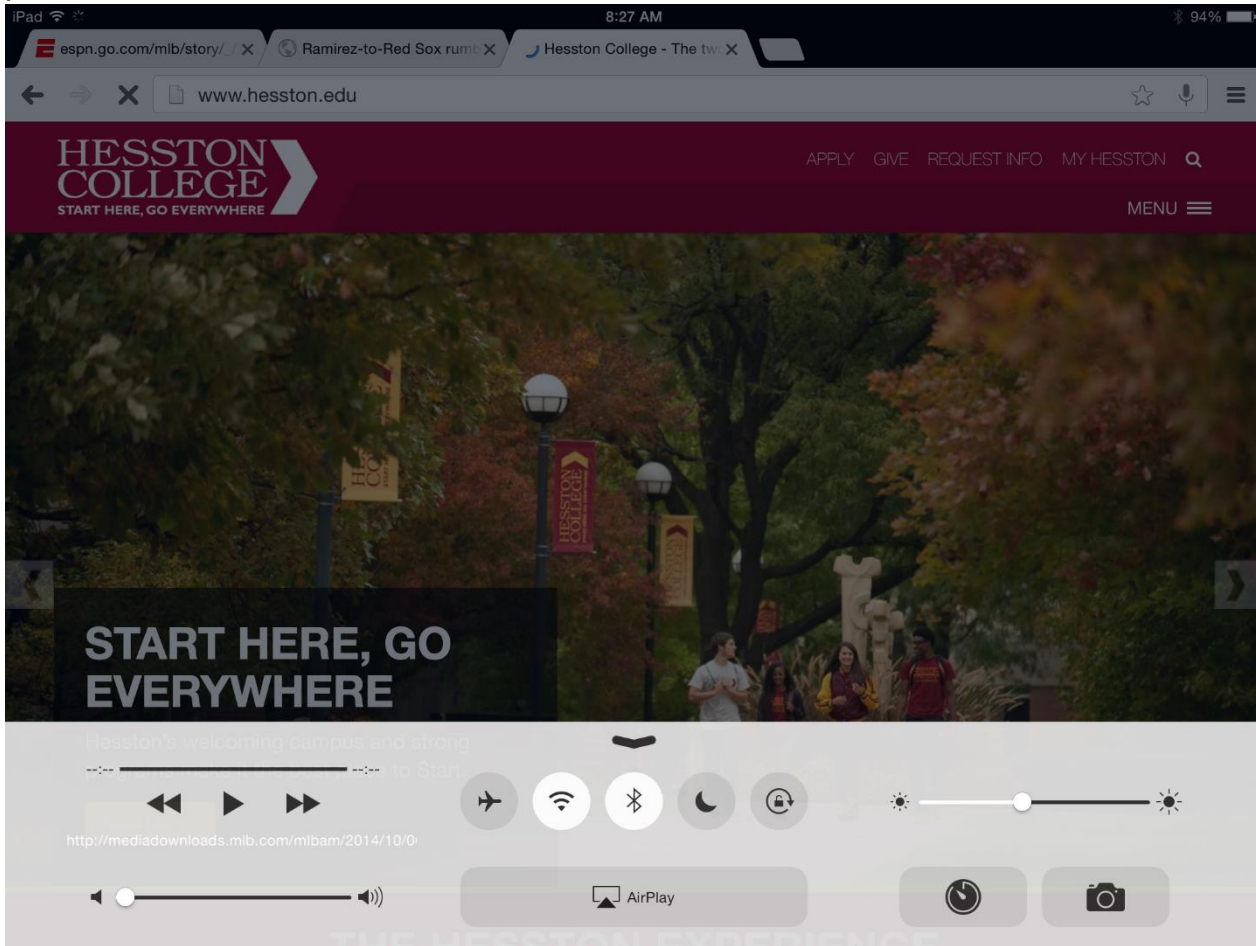
Double click the Reflector icon on desktop



You will see the Reflector icon show up on lower right of your toolbar, so you know it's turned on.



On your iPad, when you are in any application, do a “4 finger swipe up” to get to the iPad control panel.

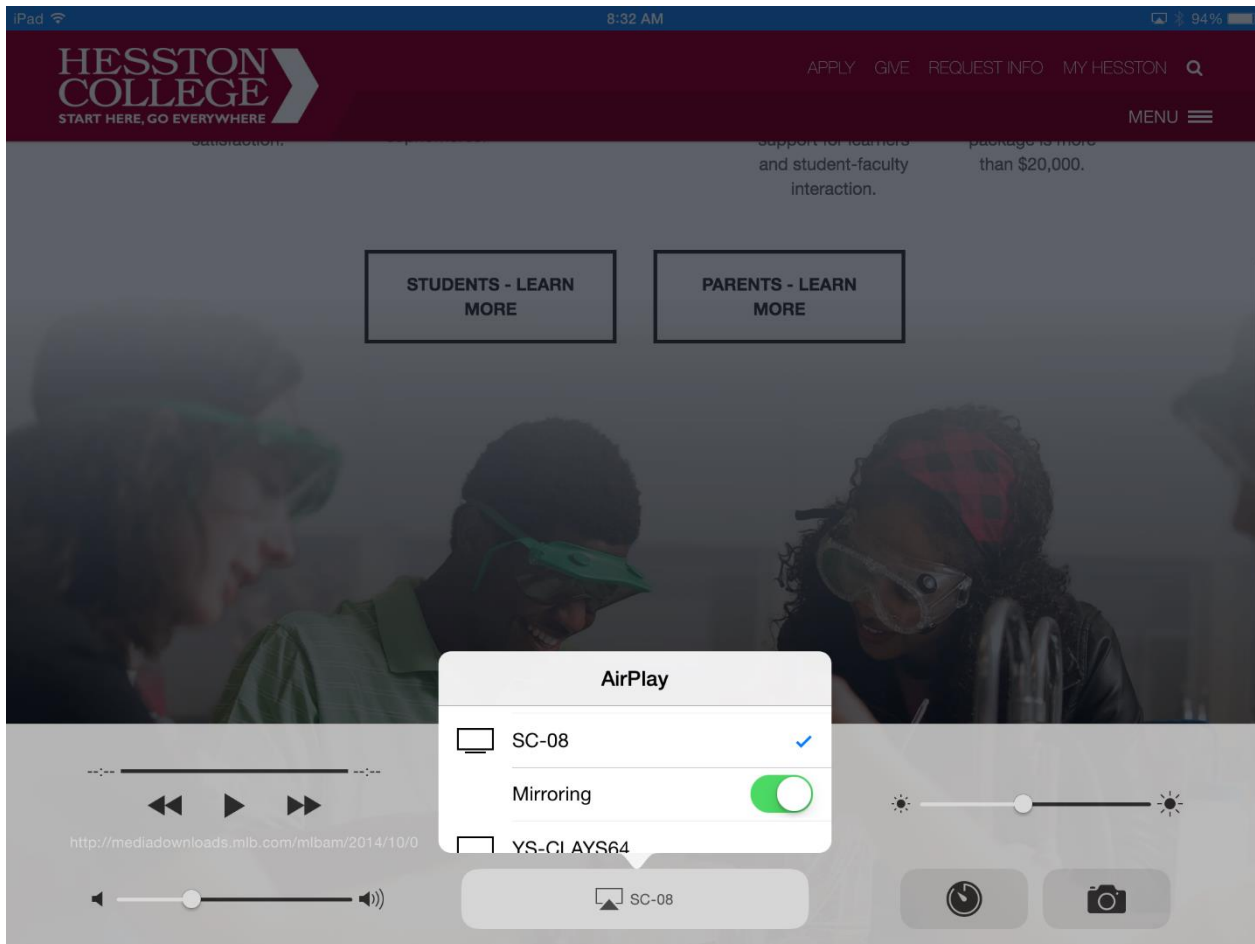


Click on the AirPlay icon in the lower middle.

After you click on that icon, in the vertical menu, select the name of classroom's computer where you are at. (You don't want to broadcast to another classroom)

When you flip the "Mirroring" switch to the right, whatever is on the iPad's screen will be sent to the computer, which will then display to the projector.

If you leave the "mirroring" off, it will play full screen if there is a secondary window, like a YouTube video.



Clicking on the main iPad screen area, will make the AirPlay control window disappear.

To quit Reflector, right click on the Reflector icon and then use the left mouse button to quit this window/application.
